

Workshop outline

Dr Sara McLean is a registered Psychologist and Research Fellow at the Australian Centre for Child Protection. Her work has focussed on the effect of early life adversity such as trauma, neglect and prenatal alcohol exposure on children's social development and behaviour. She has developed a series of user-friendly resources that address common issues found amongst children with difficult to manage behaviour. In many instances, children's difficulties are underpinned by delays in executive functioning, sensory regulation, emotional expression and language. In this workshop, Dr McLean will outline the connection between these skills and behaviour problems, and introduce participants to the resources that she has developed that detail strategies to support children's development in these key areas.
