The CAFFSA Out of Home Care Sector Workforce Mapping Project has been funded by Skills SA (Department of Education formally Department for Innovation and Skills) to identify key challenges faced by the child protection workforce, and identify current gaps that are needed to equip the sector with the skills, expertise and knowledge required to improve outcomes for children, young people and families in South Australia.

This project will be focusing on the workforce in the areas of Foster Care, Residential Care, Specialist and Disability Care and Supported Independent Living. The project is looking at three priority areas:
