## Who Is Eligible to Undertake Fee Free Vocational Education?

To be eligible for Fee Free vocational education, an individual must at the time the course commences:

- Identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person
- Live or work in South Australia
- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent Australia resident, or an eligible visa holder
- Be 16 years or over and not enrolled at school

Applicants must also meet any specific academic entry requirements for individual courses and enroll before 31 December 2024.
